General Information for Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is given on a need basis only. It will be assumed that in most cases the family will have some resources to contribute towards the expenses of playing Drifters. Approximate family income and dependents will be considered, as will unexpected debt such as medical, loss of job, death in the family, and other similar events.

Assistance will be given from season-to-season, not a yearly basis. In other words, a player receiving assistance for the fall season, August to December, will be reevaluated before assistance is given for the spring season, January to June. **If the player has followed the guidelines as outlined, assistance will automatically continue from the fall season to the spring season.**

In order for assistance to continue from season-to-season, the following guidelines apply:

PLAYER EXPECTATIONS

- 1. To participate in at least 90% of all practices*
- 2. To maintain a good attitude towards the coach and team*
- 3. To attend all games and tournaments, unless there is a valid reason (such as injury)*
- 4. To follow the Code of Conduct, as outlined in the player contract*

PARENT/GUARDIAN EXPECTATIONS

- 1. To assure that the player attends practices, games and tournaments*
- 2. To communicate effectively with the coach*
- 3. To be involved in all Drifter activities that their child's team is assigned, such as fund-raisers and attending team meetings*
- 4. To stay current on their part of monthly dues*
